
FORENSIC VIEWS OF THE BODY

Dr. Krinsky's Notes, Sylvia Hunt case, 1986

16 October 1986 - met at ~2 P.M. in my office with Det. Kamiński.
He showed me color photographs of scene where body was found. Photos of rug - closed, opened + with body exposed. All taken night of 21 Sept. 1986.

Impressions:



cut in rug - made by P.D. when opening rug.
bagging
bag
pupa (5)

plastic bag over torso,
right wrist tied with rope - rope
bound around left wrist. Body
with back to ground.

Maggot activity: Almost no maggots around or on head. Puparia averaged about anterior end and periphery of rest of body.
Abundant maggot feeding in inguinal region and less abundantly feeding on decomposed right arm (hand & wrist).

According to Det. Kamiński, when black plastic bag was removed, maggots "swarmed" out of the body from large opening in chest. Presumably, maggots were feeding on exposed viscera under plastic bag. When bag was removed under bright lights, maggots actively migrated to seek shelter and darkness. This is apparent from mass of maggots along left inner arm ~~sp~~ from wrist to axilla.
Maggots on torso obviously mature: based on size + crop size $\leq \frac{1}{2}$ length of body.

All stab wounds on chest and abdomen. Large transverse cut across chest infested with maggots.

Puparia seen on underside of rug surface that was enclosed in roll indicating migration of 1st larvae into folds.
